PART-1-GENERAL

Short title and commencement Status of the Service	1.(i)These rules may be called the Uttar Pradesh Information Department Film Photo Unit Service Rules, 1993. (ii) They shall come into force at once. 2. The Uttar Pradesh Information Department Film Photo Unit Service comprises Group'B', 'C' and 'D' posts.
Definitions.	3. In these rules unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context:- (a) "Appointing authority" means the Director of Information and Public Relations Department, Uttar Pradesh (b) ' Citizen of India' means a person who is or is deemed to be a citizen of India, under part II of the constitution; (c) 'Subordinate Commission' means the Uttar Pradesh subordinate Service Selection Commission; (d) "Constitution" means the Constitution of India; (e)"Director' means the Director of

- Information Public Relations and Department Uttar Pradesh;
- (f) 'Directorate' means the office of the Director of Information and Public Relations Department, Uttar Pradesh;
- (g) "Government" means the State Government of Uttar Pradesh;
- (h) "Governor" means the Governor of Uttar Pradesh:
- (i) "Member of the Service" means a person substantively appointed under these rules or the rules or orders in force prior to the commencement of these rules to a post in the cadre of service;
- (j) "Service" means the Uttar Pradesh Information Department Film Photo Unit Service;
- (k) "Substantive appointment" means an appointment, not being an ad-hoc appointment on a post in the cadre of the Service made after selection accordance with the rules and if there are rules, in accordance with procedure prescribed for the time being by executive instructions issued by the Government.
- (I) "Year of recruitment" means a period of twelve months commencing from the first day of July of a calendar year.

PART-II-CADRE

Cadre of Service

- 4.(i) The Strength of the Service and of each category of the posts therein shall be as such as may be determined by the Government from time o time.
- (ii) The strength of the Service and of each category of posts therein shall, until orders varying the same are passed under sub-rule (1), be as given in the appendix.
- Provided that:-
- (i) the appointing authority may leave unfilled or the Governor may hold in abeyance any vacant post, without thereby entitling any persons to compensation;

Preferential Qualification:	9. A candidate who has: (i) Served in the Territorial Army for a minimum period of two years; or (ii) Obtained a "B" certificate of National Cadet Corp shall, other things being equal, be given preference in the matter of direct recruitment.
Age	10. A candidate for direct recruitment must have attained the age of twenty one years and must not have attained the age of more than thirty two years On the first day of the recruitment in which vacancies are advertised: Provided that the upper age limit in the case of candidates belonging to the scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and such other categories as may be notified by the Government from time to time shall be greater by such number of years as may be specified.
Character	11. The character of a candidate for direct recruitment to a post in the service must be such as to render him suitable in all respects for employment in Government service. The appointing authority shall satisfy itself on this point.

Note:	Persons dismissed by the Union Government or State Government or by a local Authority or a Corporation or Body owned or controlled by the Union Government or a State Government shall be ineligible for appointment to any post in the Service. Persons convicted of any offence involving moral turpitude shall also be ineligible.
Martial status	12. A male candidate who has more than one wife living or a female candidate who has married a man already having a wife living, shall be ineligible for appointment to a post in the service: Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that there exist special grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
Physical fitness	13. No candidate shall be appointed to a post in the Service unless he be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of his duties. Before a candidate is finally approved for appointment, he shall be required to produce a Medical Certificate of fitness from Medical Board/Chief Medical Officer ,as the case may be: Provided that a medical certificate of fitness shall not be required from a candidate recruited by promotion.
	PART-V PROCIDURE FOR RECRUITMENT
Determination of vacancies	14. The appointing authority shall determine the number of vacancies to be filled during the year of recruitment as also the number of vacancies to be reserved for candidates belonging to the Schedule Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other categories under rule 6. The vacancies to be filled through the Commission shall be intimated to them. The vacancies to be filled directly through the Departmental Selection Commettee shall be

notified to the Employment Exchange. The appointing authority may also invite application directly from the persons who their names registered in the Employment Exchange. For this purpose, the appointing authority shall issue an advertisement in a Local Daily newspaper besides pasting the notice for the same on the notice Board. All such application shall be placed before the Selection Committee.

Procedure for direct recruitment through the Commission.

- 15. (1) Application for being considered for selection shall be called by the Commission in the form published in the advertisement issued by the Commission.
 - (2) The Commission shall, having regard to the need for securing due representation of the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other categories in accordance with rule 6 call for interview such number of candidate who fulfill the requisite qualifications as they consider proper.
 - (3) The Commission shall prepare a list of candidates in order of their proficiency as disclosed by the marks obtained by each candidate in the interview. If two or more candidates obtain equal marks the Commission shall arrange their names in order of merit on the basis of their general suitability for the service. The number of the names in the list shall be larger (but no larger by more then 25 percent) than the number of the vacancies. The Commission shall forward the list to the appointing authority.

Procedure for direct recruitment through the Departmental Selection Committee.

- 16. (1) For the purpose of Direct recruitment, there shall be constituted a Departmental Selection Committee comprising:-
 - (i) Appointing authority.
 - (ii) An officer belonging to Scheduled Caste or Schedule Tribe, nominated by

District Magistrate, if the appointing authority does not belongs Scheduled Caste or Schedule Tribe. If the appointing authority belongs to Scheduled Caste or Schedule Tribe, an officer other than belonging Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe to he nominated bv the District Magistrate.

(iii) Two officers nominated by the appointing authority one of whom shall be an officer belonging to backward class. If such suitable officers are not available in his department, such suitable officers shall on the request of the appointing authority be nominated by the District Magistrate and on his failure to do so, by reason of non-availability of suitable officers, such officers shall be nominated by the Divisional Commissioner.

- (2) All the applications received under rule shall be placed before Selection Committee. Departmental The Departmental Selection Committee shall scrutinize all the applications and shall having regard to the need for due representation of the securing candidates belong Scheduled to Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other categories in accordance with rule 6 call for interview such number of candidates as have come up to the standard fixed by the Committee in this respect.
- (3) The Departmental selection Committee shall prepare a list of candidates in order of proficiencies as disclosed by the marks obtained in the interview. If two or more candidates obtain equal marks, The Departmental Selection Committee shall arrange their general suitability for the post. The number of the names in the list shall be larger (but not larger by more than 25%) than the number of vacancies. The Departmental Selection Committee shall forward the list to the appointing

Procedure for recruitment by promotion through the Selection committee	17. (i) Recruitment by promotion shall be made on the basis of seniority subject to the rejection of the unfit through the Selection Committee comprising: (i) Director Chairman (ii)Two officer of the directorate not below Members the rank of Deputy Director to be nominated by the Director. (2) The appointing authority shall prepare eligibility lists of the candidates in accordance with the Uttar Pradesh Promotion by Selection(on posts outside the purview of the Public Service Commission) Eligibility List Rules ,1986 , and place the same before the Selection Committee along with their Character-rolls and such other record pertaining to them, as may be considered proper: Provided that while preparing eligibility lists under this sub-rule , where these are two or more different feeding cadres: (a) bearing different pay-scales, the candidates belonging to the cadre bearing higher pay scale shall be placed higher in the eligibility lists. PART -VI APPOINTMENT, PROBATION, CONFIRMATION AND SENIORITY

CONFIRMATION AND SENIORITY Appointment 19. (1) Subject to the provision of sub rule (2) the appointing authority shall make a appointment by taking the names of candidates in the order in which they stand in the lists prepared under rule 15 or 16 or 17 or 18 as the case may be. (2) Where, in any year of recruitment appointments are to be made both by direct recruitment and by promotion. Regular appointments shall not be made unless selections are made from both the sources, and a combined list is prepared accordance with rule 18. (3) If more than one order of appointment are issued in respect of any one selection, a combined order shall also be issued, mentioning the names of the persons in order of seniority as determined in the selection or, as the case may be, as it stood in the cadre from which they are promoted, if the appointments are made both by direct recruitment and by promotion, names shall be arranged in accordance with the order, referred to in rule 18. **Probation** 20(1) A person substantives appointed to a post in the Service shall be placed on probation for a period of two years. (2) The appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded, extend the period of probation in individual cases specifying the exact date up to which the extension is aranted: Provided that, save in exceptional

circumstances, the period of probation shall not be extended beyond one year and in no circumstance beyond two years. (3) If it appears to the appointing authority at any time during or at the end of the period of probation or extended period of probation, that a probationer has not made sufficient use of his opportunities or has otherwise failed to give satisfaction, he may be reverted to his substantive post, if any and if he does not hold a lien on any post, his services may be dispensed with. (4) A probationer who is reverted or whose services are dispensed with under sub-rule not be entitled to (3) shall compensation. (5)The appointing authority may allow continuous service rendered in a post included in the cadre or any other equivalent or higher post, to be taken into account for purposes of computing the period of probation. Confirmation 21. (1) Subject to the provisions of sub-rule (2) a probationer shall be confirmed in his appointment at the end of the period of probation or the extended period of probation if:-(a) His work and conduct are reported to be satisfactory, (b) His integrity is certified. and (c) the appointing authority is satisfied that he is otherwise fit for confirmation. (2) Where, in accordance with the provision of the Uttar Pradesh State Government Confirmation Servant Rules, confirmation is not necessary, the order under sub-rule (3) of rule 5 of those rules declaring that the person concerned has successfully completed the probation shall be deemed to be the order of confirmation. Pay during probation (1) Notwithstanding any provision in the Fundamental Rules to the contrary, a person on probation, if he is not already in permanent Government Service, shall be allowed his first increment in the time scale when he has completed one year of satisfactory has service, passed departmental examination and undergone training, where prescribed, and second increment after two years service when he has completed the probationary period and is also confirmed. Provided that if the period of probation is extended an account of failure to give satisfaction such extension shall not count for increment unless the appointing authority direct otherwise. (2)The pay during probation of a person who was already holding a post under the Government service be regulated by the relevant fundamental rules. Provided that if the period of probation

Provided that if the period of probation is extended an account of failure to give satisfaction such extending shall not count for increment unless the appointing authority directs otherwise.

(3) The pay during the probation of a The pay during probation person already in permanent Government service shall be regulated by the relevant rules, applicable generally to Government servants serving in connection with the affairs of the State.

Criterian for Crossing Efficiency Bar

24. No person shall be allowed to cross efficiency bar unless his work and conduct is found to be satisfactory and unless his integrity is certified.

PART VIII-OTHER PROVISIONS

Canvassing

25. No recommendations, either written or oral, other than those required under the rules applicable to the post or Service will be

taken into consideration. Any attempt on the part of a candidate to enlist support directly or indirectly for his candidature will disqualify him for appointment.

Regulation of other 26. matters

In regard to the matters not specifically covered by these rules or special orders, persons appointed to the service shall be governed by the rules regulations and orders applicable generally to Government servants serving in connection with the affairs of the State.

conditions of service

Relaxation from the 27. Where the State Government is satisfied that the operation of any rule regulating the conditions of service of persons appointed to the Service causes undue hardship in any particular case, it may notwithstanding anything contained in the rules applicable to the case by order dispense with or relax the requirement of that rule to such extent and subject to such conditions as it may consider necessary for dealing with the case in a just and equitable manner.

> Provided that where a rule has been framed in consultation with the Commission that body shall be consulted before the requirements of the rule are dispensed with or relaxed.

Savings

28. Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations and other concessions required to be provided for the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in orders accordance with the of Government issued from time to time in this regard.
